This event is sure to bring new ideas to your teaching repertoire, along with fun and educational instruction to your choir members.

The festival will take place in the ECC music department, which is housed in Hansen Hall on the campus of East Central College in Union, MO. Each choir will have 30 minutes of warm-up time in a private room, followed by 30 minutes of public performance/clinic time in the John Edson Anglin Performing Arts Center. Choirs will prepare 2 selections (no more than a combined total of 10 minutes in length) for performance. Immediately following the performance, Mrs. Warger will provide a clinic of up to 15 minutes with the choir. A piano will be provided in the warm up room, as well as for the performance in the theater. Please specify on the registration form if "special set up" is required (extra music stands, chairs, etc.); also specify if percussion instruments will need to be set up for performance.
